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102.1 ~~Evaluation of School District, Schools and Programs~~ Review of District and School Programs

Policy

The District, its schools, and its programs shall be ~~evaluated on an annual basis. The purposes of the evaluation are to~~ reviewed ~~for the following purposes:~~

- ~~determine schools' effectiveness in meeting the educational needs of students;~~
- determine the extent to which ~~the District and school~~ the District and school goals ~~delineated in the Education Plans~~ delineated in the Education Plans are being accomplished;
- determine ~~how effectively and efficiently processes and practices are carried out~~ whether the processes and practices implemented to achieve District and school goals are effective and efficient; and
- ~~determine schools' effectiveness in meeting the educational needs of students;~~
- suggest directions for growth and improvement to ensure the best possible educational experiences.

Regulations

1. ~~An evaluation~~ A review of the District, including District programs:
 - 1.1 shall be conducted each year using the District Combined Three Year Education Plan and Annual Education Results Report required by Alberta Education. ~~Contents of the report are prescribed in the Guide for Developing School Board Three-Year Education Plans and Annual Education Results Report.~~
 - 1.2 may be conducted in greater depth at the direction of the Board.
2. ~~An evaluation~~ A review of each school, including its programs:
 - 2.1 shall be conducted each year using the school's Combined Three Year Education Plan and Annual Education Results Report.
 - 2.2 may be conducted in greater depth at the direction of Executive Council and/or the Board.
3. A formal evaluation of a specific program, department, school, or the District as a whole may be conducted as required at the direction of the Superintendent and/or the Board, ~~or the Superintendent.~~
4. Opportunities will be provided for stakeholder feedback at the District and/or school level, as appropriate, ~~at regular intervals as directed by the Board.~~

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to develop the procedures necessary to implement this policy.
