#### c. Academics

#### d. Registration Process

- Grade 11 and 12 registrations worked smoothly
- Grade 10 and 9 system didn't provide enough information resulting in waits. We will make changes to streamline things for next year.
- Province is working with weighted average so students we lost during COVID are not in the count so Government is funding us for 1,100 students vs 1,300 students.
- Concerns raised regarding children butting line to make changes. Some parents took off several hours from work to help their students, some students were with grade level admin for 40 minutes with questions, suggesting work through Teams so the order is set on first come first serve, the best place to see the schedule is on Power School rather than the print out.
- Could there be tours ahead of time for new to LCI families?
- Appreciation expressed for only grade 9 on the first day.
- Could staff and leadership students wear LCI shirts for the first week not just the grade 9 day as it can be difficult for grade 9s to know who to ask for help once all grades are in the halls on the second day.
- 1360 kids registered in May then 1310 arrived in September. The challenge is we don't necessarily know who has moved so it takes a few weeks for us to know what the accurate numbers are.

- Until we get more money in for funding we have to prioritize core subjects before adding more options.
