!!!! IMPORTANT DISTINCTION IN THE REGISTRATION PROCESS !!!!

Online Parent Registration Link – This refers to the online forms that parents must complete through Laserfiche. Alberta Education requires a new updated registration form for every student in the province. This requirement can be fulfilled by clicking on the link between the designated dates and updating the form for each of you children

Student PowerSchool Course Requests – This refers to the process where students log into their **STUDENT POWERSCHOOL ACCOUNTS** and then select the classes they hope to take next year. Students should make sure they can log into their PowerSchool accounts **BEFORE** May 7th so they are ready to make selections when the time comes
