Parents should register their students via PowerSchool for a seat on their bus. Rider lists are compiled from those registrations so if you do not register, a seat may not be saved for your child. Students who have registered are already being issued a Bus Route Sticker to go on their LCI Student ID Card. Students will be expected to display their ID with the appropriate sticker on demand to any driver to prove they are registered to be riding that bus. Students should ensure that they have a student ID card by getting their picture taken on photo day, or by visit



Please note that only students that live OUTSIDE a 2 Km radius from the school will qualify for bussing.
