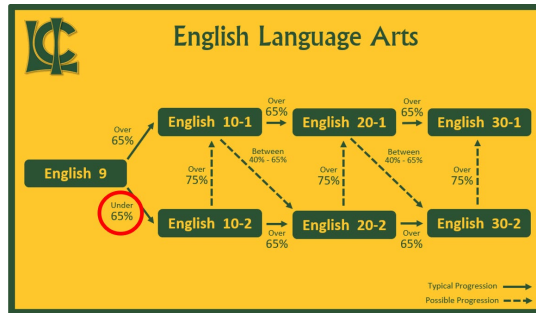

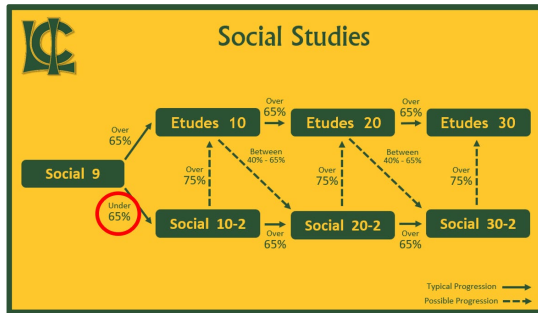

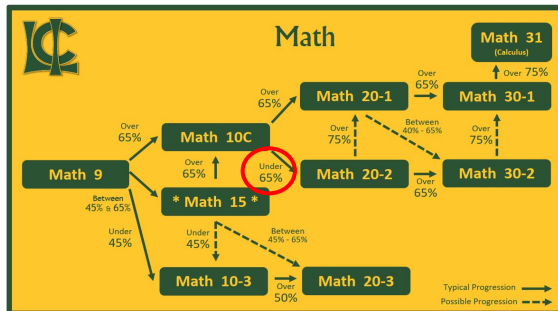
# Prerequisites & Which Stream Should You Take?



*Dash 1 and Dash 2 classes are both academically challenging courses that can get you into many different post secondary programs. Dash 3 classes will also get you into many postsecondary programs*



*If you complete a core class with less than a 70%, you should strongly consider taking a different stream. Anything less than a 65% will likely result with a recommendation to take a different stream*

# ***Make Sure You Know Your PowerSchool Password***



*All students should have the PowerSchool App on their phone already. They should also know their PowerSchool login credentials*
