!!!! IMPORTANT DISTINCTION IN THE REGISTRATION PROCESS !!!!

Online Parent Registration Link – This refers to the online forms that parents must complete through School Engage within PowerSchool. Alberta Education requires a new updated registration form for every student in the province each year. This requirement can be fulfilled by logging into your parent PowerSchool accounts between the designated dates and updating the form for <u>each</u> of your children. Detailed Instructions will be emailed to parents the day before registration opens in PowerSchool (March 10th)

Student PowerSchool Course Requests – This refers to the process where students log into their **STUDENT POWERSCHOOL ACCOUNTS** and then select the classes they hope to take next year. Students should make sure they can log into their PowerSchool accounts **BEFORE** March 11th so they are ready to make selections when the time comes.

Key Points to Remember

Current Grade 9's going into Grade 10

- You must select at least 40 credits but no more than 50
- You must select a Phys Ed/CALM class (even if you plan on summer school)
- You must select an English, Social, Math & Science class
- You will NOT be allowed to choose any 20 level classes
- You will NOT be allowed to select Scimatics

If you want to request a 20 level course in your grade 10 year you must fill out a "20 Level Request Form" and submit it to the office before March 25th

If you are interested in taking Scimatics, you must fill out an application form and return it to Mrs. Scott before March 25th





Current Grade 10's going into Grade 11

- You must select at least 30 credits but no more than 50
- You will not be forced to select any particular number of core subjects, so it is important for you to know which classes you need, and which ones have already completed
- You will NOT be allowed to choose any 30 level classes

If you want to request a 30 level course in your grade 11 year you must scan the QR code and fill out the MS Form to make your 30 level requests





Current Grade 11's going into Grade 12

- You must select at least 20 credits
- You will not be forced to select any particular number of core subjects, so it is important for you to know which classes you need, and which ones have already completed
- You are not restricted in any other way it the courses you can select



Students must long into PowerSchool which can be done from the LCI website

Course Requests must be made on a PC (the app does not have course request capability)

You can log into PowerSchool by using the menu on the left hand side of the screen titled "PowerSchool"

This is where you need to know your login ID and Password



How to reset your PowerSchool Password:

- Go to the LCI website (do this on the website not in your app!)
- Click on the PowerSchool button
- Click on the forgot username or password button as shown here.
- Then enter your PowerSchool Username and your school email address (you can get your username from the office, your advisor, or find it within your PowerSchool app account)

Check your SCHOOL email for the password reset email (it may be in your junk or other folder). Follow prompts to reset your password. Write down your username and password or you will need to continue doing this process every time you forget your log in.





Class Registration in PowerSchool

Once you are logged in, you will want to find the menu down the right hand side of the screen. We will be working out of link titled **"Class Registration"**

Once you click on that, you will be taken to the page where you will make your course requests

What if I don't make my course requests on time

Students have until

Tuesday, March 25th

to make their course requests in PowerSchool If students do not make their course requests on time (this include filling out 20 or 30 level request forms) then two problems occur:

1st - The school will not have accurate numbers from which to build the master schedule and have enough class spaces available to the students that need them

2nd - You will not have a timetable and will be left with what ever classes are left over after all timetable changes have been made for other students
