Online Parent Registration Link – This refers to the online forms that parents must complete through School Engage within PowerSchool. Alberta Education requires a new updated registration form for every student in the province each year. This requirement can be fulfilled by logging into your PowerSchool accounts between the designated dates and updating the information for your children. Detailed instructions will be provided in the registration opens in Powerschool (March 10th)

What Happens If...

...you don't complete your Course Requests in PowerSchool by the END OF THE DAY

PowerSchool will not put you in classes while everyone else is put in classes

Everyone else will have a timetable ready for them when they are given out on May 27th

You will not have a timetable, and your course schedule will be blank when you see it

Only after everyone else is placed will we be able to build you a timetable and your course availability will be VERY limited

While everyone else is getting timetable changes made and getting in the courses they need and want, you will have to wait



For Current Grade 9 Students...

If you want to request a 20 level course in your grade 10 year you must fill out a “20 Level Request Form” and submit it to the office before March 25th

If you are interested in taking Scimatics, you must fill out an application form and return it to Mrs. Scott in room C311 before March 25th

For Current Grade 10 students...

If you want to request a 30 level course in your grade 11 year you must scan the QR code and fill out the MS Form to make your 30 level requests





Where to go for Course Requests?

Students must log into PowerSchool which can be done from the LCI website

Course Requests must be made in a browser (the app does not have course request capability)

You can log into PowerSchool by using the menu on the right hand side of the screen titled "PowerSchool"

This is where you need to know your login ID and Password





Admission requirements

For admission, Canadian high school students in Alberta must have completed five of the following courses with a minimum 65% average across them:

This course

- English Language Arts 30-1

Three of these courses

- Aboriginal Studies 30
- Art 30 or Art 31
- Biology 30
- Chemistry 30
- Choral Music 30, General Music 30, or Instrumental Music 30
- Dance 35
- Drama 30
- Mathematics 30-1 or Mathematics 30-2
- Mathematics 31
- Physics 30
- Science 30
- Social Studies 30-1
- Five credits in Advanced-level CTS Computer Science (CSE)
- One or more distinct languages at the 30 level

One additional

- That has not already been used
- May be from the list above
- Must be at the 30 level
- Must be worth at least five credits (multiple courses worth a total of five or more credits can be used)
- Cannot be a Special Project

This program also requires

One of the courses you include must be:

- Mathematics 30-1 or 30-2
