#### 3. Reports: Administrator – Gordon Vatcher

- Capital plan update – LCI has been approved for pre planning money for modernization! The government will now give money to start get an evaluation on the building.
- Registration/ Schedule update – Working through Advisor Periods to get student's course selections in with the goal of having everything finished before the end of the school year. All current students at LCI will need to have course selection completed by March 25. We will be able to build the master schedule off the actual student numbers this year.
  - o **Requesting all students complete their course selection prior to March 25<sup>th</sup> because it will be very difficult for students to get into what they want if they miss this deadline.**
- **Grade 9 Science** – The plan at this time is to not offer the year long Grade 9 Science. There were some challenges with the pilot with the class dynamics.
  - o **Discussion:** Concerns raised about students who need a full year science course to absorb all the materials.
- **Quality Assurance survey**- grade 10 families
  - o Students are getting them completed during the school day
  - o Parent response is low. We hope to see more parent engagement before the survey closed.
- **AED's follow up** – LCI has purchased another AED that is installed by small gym.
  - o Christine Light was going to look into things with the school division to see if we could purchase a 3<sup>rd</sup> one for the G wing. **Tiffany will follow up with Christine.**
  - o We have had discussions about adding some new programs, "Cardiac Care" and "Stop the Bleed" that will be integrated into the Grade 9 PE class. EMS is going to partner to talk with students. LCI would like to be a leader in training more student.
  - o Sport Medicine class goal is to expose students to community health.
