Return Your Textbooks!


Textbooks and novel studies should be returned as soon as they are no longer needed by the student

- Textbooks can be returned directly to the Textbook Centre (D100 around the corner from the elevator) **during exams**
- Textbooks can also be returned in the main library book bin prior to exams
- If textbooks are not returned, students will not be able to take out any textbooks next year
- Any fees will be allocated to SchoolCash Online for unreturned or lost materials

- Students are allowed to bring in a drink and a snack for their exams



Timetable Change Requests for 2025/2026

For students: please **do not double message your administrator!** This will cause you to lose your place in line as they are working from the earliest messages to the oldest.

Example: If you messaged Mr. McKenzie at 7:10 am, you have a place very early. However, if you message him again at 10:30am, you will lose your place in line from your 7:30am message.

All timetable change requests must be submitted before the deadline of 3:00 pm on Tuesday, June 10th.

No additional changes to student timetables will be made until classes resume in the fall.

At that point, students will have until the end of the 1st week of classes to request add/drops.

PowerSchool does NOT open until after the school year “roll over” that happens over the summer break. Therefore, all students will get a paper copy of their timetable from their advisor teacher on Tuesday, May 27th. *(Students with incomplete registrations will NOT get their timetable until after the online registration has been completed in PowerSchool).* Students will be able to utilize the paper copy of their timetable, in combination with the Master Schedule that is posted on the LCI website to make sure they have all the courses they need and where they need them.



NOTE: If you require assistance, select the **SUPPORT** option in the top right hand corner of the screen.


Step 1: Register

- If you have not registered, please go to the *School Cash Online* home page <https://lethbridge.schoolcashonline.com/> and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- Complete each of the three Registration Steps
*For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.



Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and *School Cash Online* account. The confirmation link will open the *School Cash Online* site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.



Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- Enter the School Board Name.
- Enter the School Name.
- Enter Your Child's Student Number (this can be found on the report card)
- Enter Your Child's Last Name and Birth Date.
- Select *Continue*.
- On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select *Continue*.
- Your child has been added to your account.
