PARENTS! PARKING, PICK-UP, & DROP-OFF

Please refrain from dropping students off in the back parking lot in the morning.

We have 18 busses that rotate through dropping off students, and 100 staff coming in to park get into the building. To prevent back up issues, please refrain from using the back parking lot to drop off students unless there are mobility concerns.

The back school parking lot cannot be used for pick up until 3:00pm.

We have 18 busses that arrive all at once and need space to load up their students and leave in a timely manner. Please pick your students up out front, or wait until 3:00pm once the busses leave to use the back parking lot.

ALL 100% of the parking stalls are reserved and assigned to staff.

Do not park in the parking lot for any reason during morning drop off, or throughout the school day as staff are coming and going from work.

Bussing for the 2025/2026 School Year

Bus drivers are starting to ask to see bus stickers on ID cards!

- If your student is registered for the bus and does not have a sticker on their ID card, please tell them to come to the office as soon as possible to get their sticker, as some drivers will turn students away.
- If you think you qualify for bussing, but do not see a bussing registration form in School Engage, please call us in the office and we can help sort that out.
- Bussing registration is to be completed through School Engage, the same way the registration form was completed (instructions below).

To complete the Bussing Registration form, please follow the steps below:

1. Go to the LCI website and click on the PowerSchool button
2. Log into your PowerSchool account
 - a. If you do not have a PowerSchool account, but have a School Engage account, please click the following link and log into your School Engage: <https://lethsd.schoolengage.ca/#/home>
3. For PowerSchool: on the left hand side, there will be a menu – click School Engage on the bottom of the menu. This should open a new screen.
4. Once in School Engage, click 'Students' and then click on your student's name
5. This should now show their information and a list of forms. Find the list of forms and click New for the "2025/2026 Bussing Registration Form"
6. Complete the information as indicated and submit the form.

If you think you qualify for bussing and do not have a form available in School Engage, please contact the transportation department at the board office at 403-380-5300

Lockers – All students have a locker, all reported issues resolved

All students have now been assigned a locker! If your student says they do not have a locker, please tell them to come to the office and we will give them their number and combination.

All **reported** locker issues have now been fixed! If your student let us know the first week of school that they had an issue with their locker, it has now been resolved and they can come to the office to get their info.
